Batch #140 is a select blend of our best barrels of mountain Cabernet Sauvignon from 2021 vintage.

Napa Valley's mountain vineyards are very difficult to farm, and they are the source of some of the best, rarest and most prestigious wines in the world.

Each of the five mountain AVAs-Atlas Peak, Mount Veeder, Diamond Mountain District, Howell Mountain, and Spring Mountain District-make up for less than 1% of the wine made in Napa Valley.

Sensational bouquet of roasted hazelnut, vanilla and sandalwood, wishing this was a cologne.

On the palate, mulberry silk smooth from start to finish with so much action on the mid-palate. Swiss chocolate, baking spice, and tobacco leaf have teamed up to steal all my attention, and left me puckering my tongue for a long minute with cedar and vanilla.
